We are delighted and excited to see so many fans come to support our programs. The energy they can provide is amazing. **New procedures will begin October 7, 2016 and are being instituted for the safety and well-being of all in attendance:**

- **No bottles** of any kind will be allowed inside our football stadium. Before entering, please dispose of all bottles in the receptacle provided.
- **No backpacks** will be allowed inside the stadium. Please leave backpacks at home or in your vehicle.
- Spectators for the football games are asked to remain in the immediate football field area. The areas behind the home bleachers are off limits as are all areas surrounding the middle school.

Additionally, please be reminded:

- Appropriate cheering and clapping are always encouraged. The NJAC conference has very specific rules about sportsmanship and fan behavior. Not adhering to these rules and/or interfering with play can have serious consequences for the team. This includes not rushing the playing field during or after a game.
- Anytime our students are performing the expectation is one of showing respect and praise.
- Many times the N.J.S.I.A.A. will have rules about what types of noise makers are allowed. We are asking that our student fans come with hands to clap and voices to cheer. Beyond that students are encouraged to check with the athletic department for advice on other types of noise makers.
- All RHS Code of Conduct policies and procedures will be enforced at all events, home and away ~ this includes the substance abuse policy. The consumption of any illegal substance prior to attending a school event or at a school event will be subject to consequences as outlined in those policies. More important than following a policy, our goal is to help our students make good decisions.
