

Thank you for your interest in the Randolph Community School's Summer Leaders program! **Summer Leaders are "Counselors-in-Training"** and are the future staff of our summer camps. Under the guidance of our camp directors and other camp staff, Summer Leaders will learn skills needed to be a good role model for campers while preparing to become a great camp counselor in the future.

## The Summer Leaders program will run from June 19th – August 11th in weekly sessions with a four-week minimum after the application is accepted.

In each session, leaders will work with the Director of the Summer Leaders program on communication, leadership, handling behaviors, and problem-solving skills. You will be assigned to a camp and/or camp group and work with camp staff to implement the skills learned. In addition to working directly with campers, Summer Leaders will be responsible for creating "Fun Friday" activities. On your application, you will have the opportunity to note your camp assignment preference. The camp selections include:

## **Summer Trailblazers** (Day camp for Kindergarten - Grade 5)

June 19 - 23, June 26 - 30, July 3 - 7 (closed July 4th), July 10 - 14, July 17 - 21, July 24 - 28, July 31 - August 4, and August 7 - 11

## **Summer Travelers** (Daily travel camp for Grades 6-8)

• June 19 - 23, June 26 - 30, July 3 - 7 (closed July 4th), July 10 - 14, July 17 - 21, July 24 - 28, July 31 - August 4, and August 7 -11

## **Summer Explorers** (Specialty camps for Grades 1-11)

- Band & Orchestra AM June 19 23, June 26 -30, July 10 14 & July 17-21
- Culinary Camp PM June 19 23, June 26 30, July 10 July 14, July 17 21, July 24 July 28, and July 31 August 4
- NEW Dance Camp AM & PM July 10 14 and July 17 21
- Vocal Camp AM July 24 28 and July 31- August 4
- Theatre Camp Session A July 10 21 (2-week session) Session B July 24 August 4 (2-week session)

The enclosed application and letters of recommendation are due by March 5, 2023. All submissions should be emailed to <a href="mailto:communityschool@rtnj.org">communityschool@rtnj.org</a>. Please put the camper's name and "Summer Leaders" in the subject line.

Applicants will be interviewed prior to program acceptance and camp assignment. *Summer Leaders Fee*: \$250 per week (includes a Summer Leader t-shirt, assigned camp activities, transportation and admission to any scheduled trip, pizza lunch on Fridays and more). **Returning Leaders will be \$200 per week.** Other discounts do not apply.
