During the spring of the 7th grade year, Randolph Middle School teachers make determinations of 8th grade placement based on several factors: most recent Grade Level Skills Assessment score, Reading Skills Assessment score, teacher's assessment of academic skills and study skills. Students will receive points based on criteria that will determine where teachers recommend students to be placed for 8th grade English Language Arts. Students have the ability to select a level lower than what a teacher recommends.
