

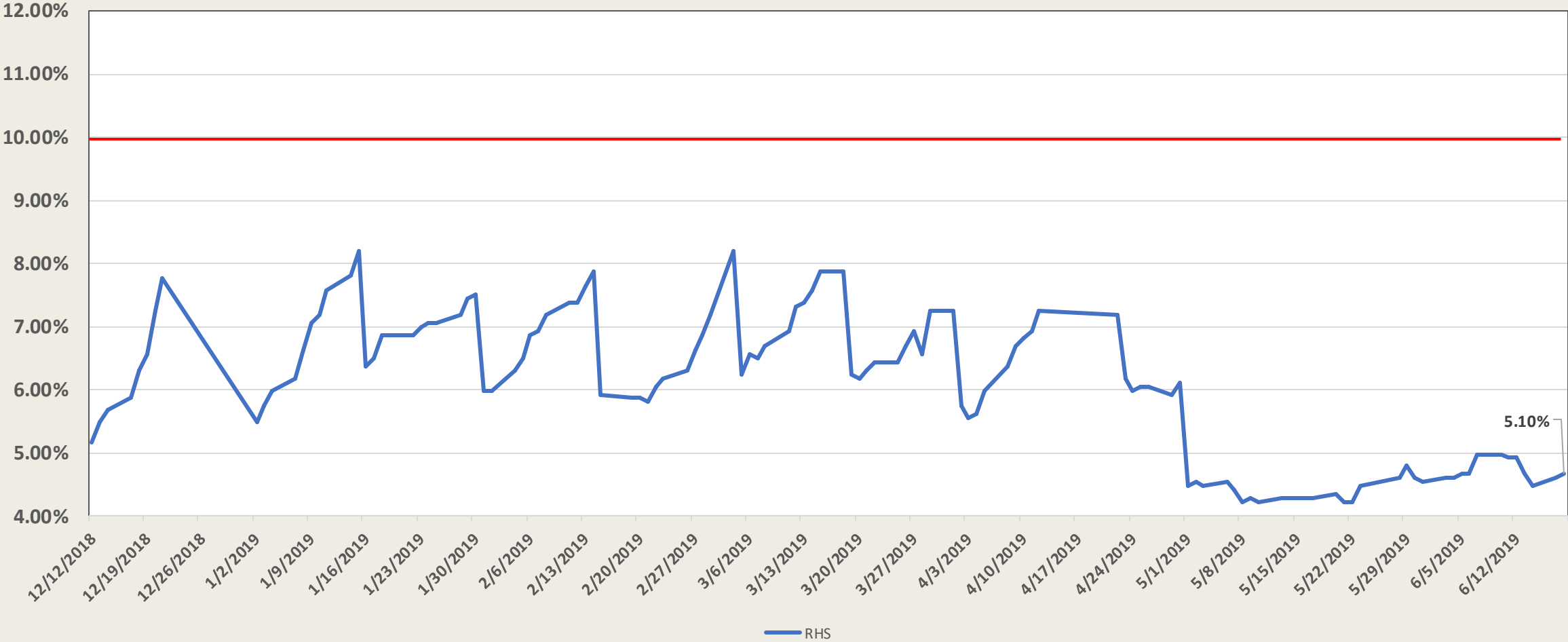

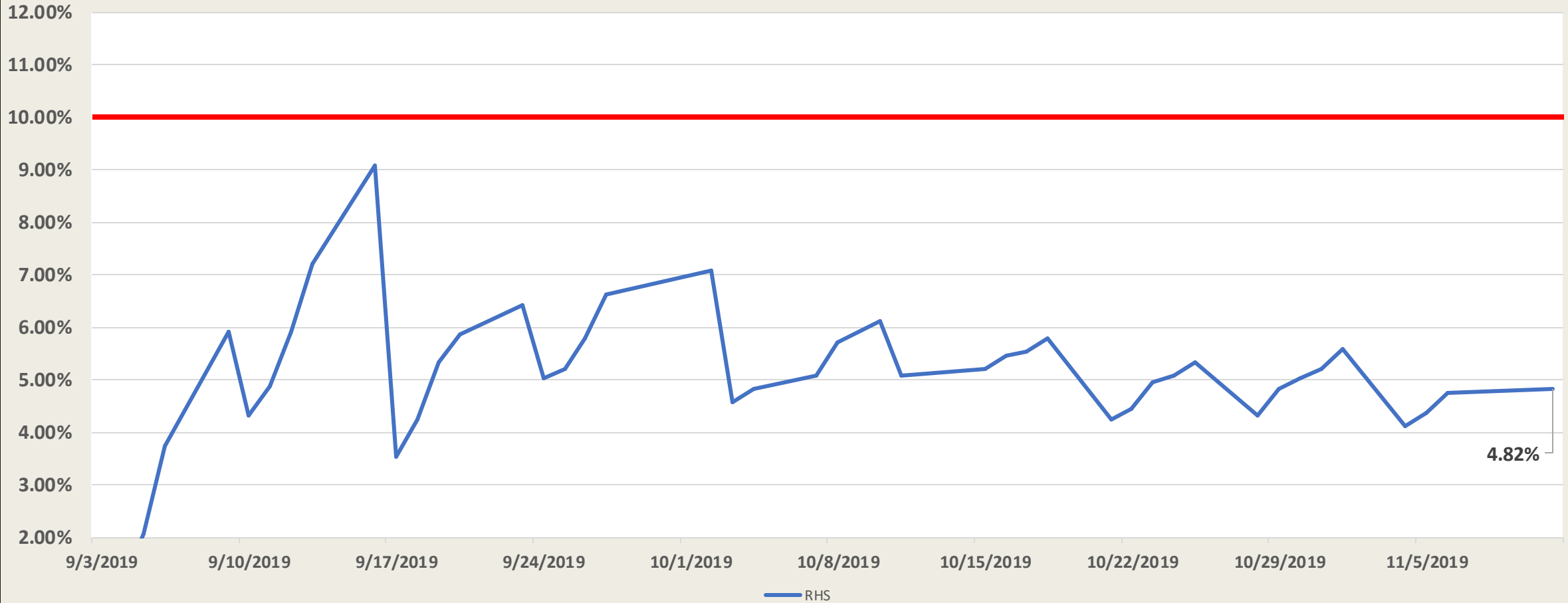
# Attendance: 2018-2019

10% Chronically Absent Daily View (report 1026): 2018-2019

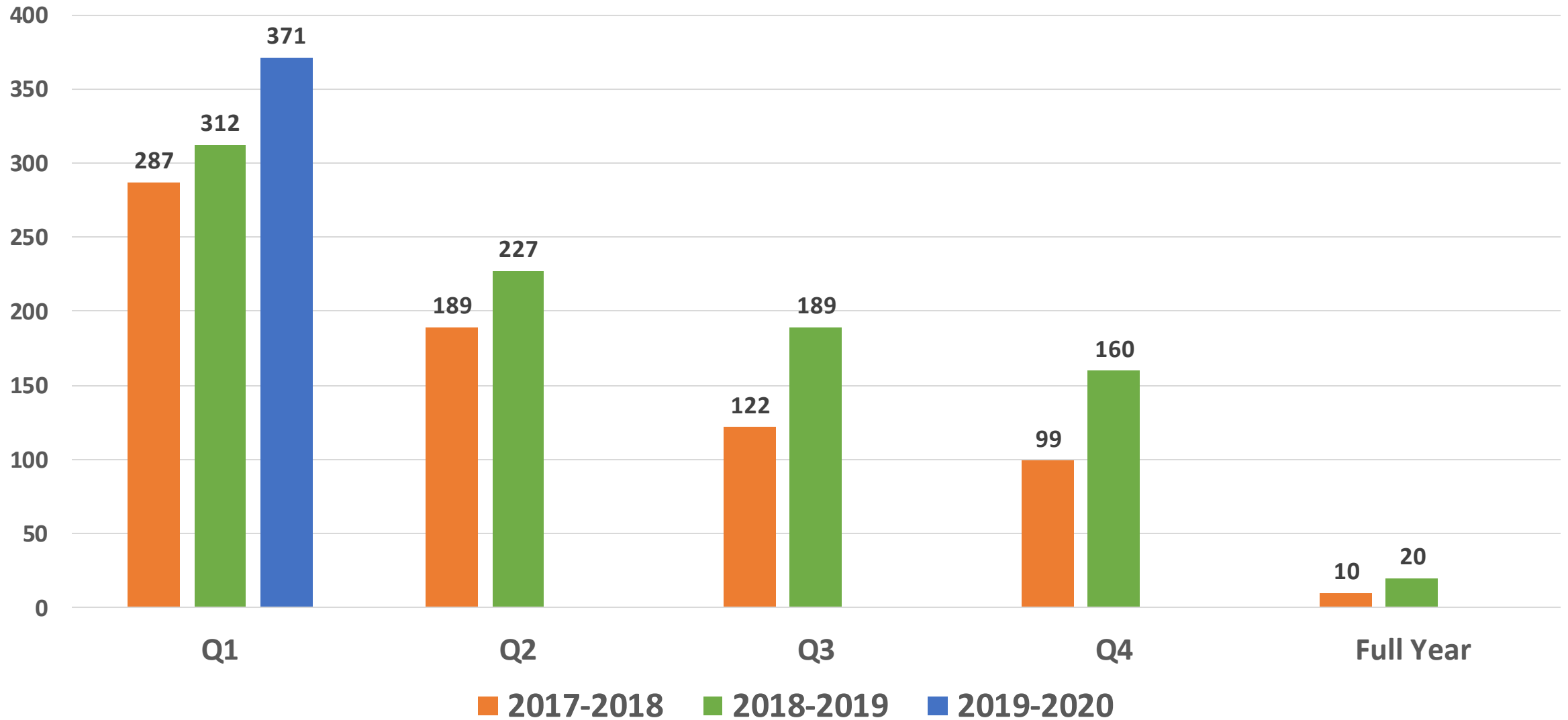


# Attendance: 2019-2020 (to date)

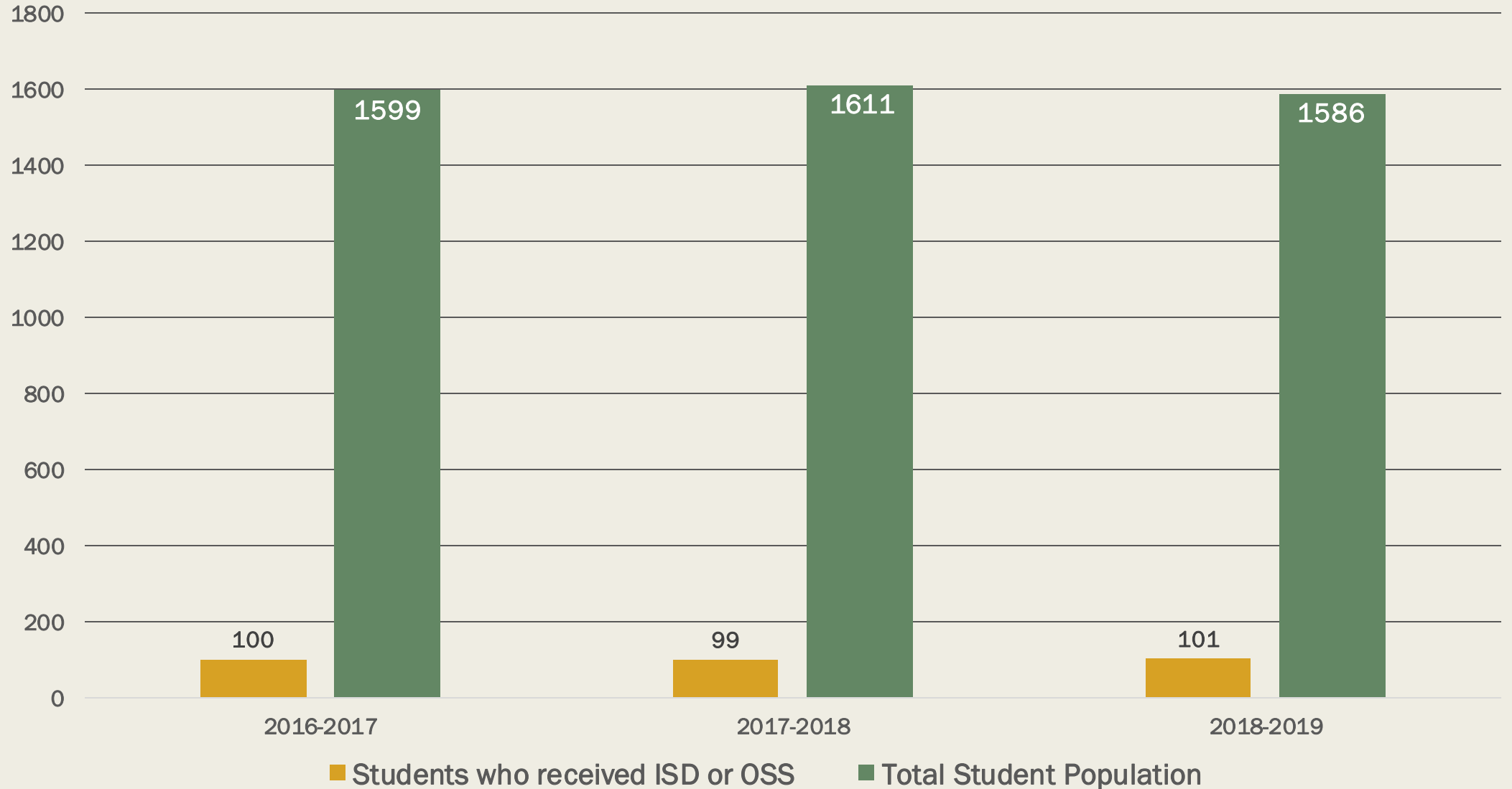
